Founded in 2007 by Bryan and Terin Ignozzi, Bryter Estates is a boutique, family-owned winery specializing in premium, hand-crafted wines from some of the best vineyards in Sonoma and Napa Valley. The name of the winery is a marriage of Bryan and Terin's names (BRY-TER) and it perfectly describes their outlook on life - *brighter!*


Originally from Chicago, Illinois, Terin Ignozzi is the daughter of an Italian immigrant and grew up making wine with her father and grandfather in the basement of her home. She has always been fascinated with the process of making wine, the range of expressions the same varietal can have from different regions, and the way wine can always bring friends and family together. From a very young age, Terin knew that wine was her passion. When her career in market research brought her to the San Francisco Bay area, she decided to reignite that passion from her youth.

Terin enrolled at UC Davis and earned her Certificate in Viticulture and Enology. She has since gained additional knowledge studying at the United States Sommelier Association, the Court of Master Sommeliers, and the Culinary Institute of America. Terin is also a member of the Guild of Sommeliers and The Wine Century Club. Finally, she is qualified as a California State Fair Wine Judge, she has passed the Level 1 Court of Master Sommeliers certificate program, and she is a candidate for the USSA Advanced Sommelier Certification. To say Terin Ignozzi is well-educated in the wine industry is certainly an understatement.

Terin started as a home winemaker, just like her father and grandfather, and after a few years decided to pursue her own label with her husband Bryan, and Bryter Estates was born. Their goal was, and still is, to create balanced, food friendly wines that are enjoyable young, while also having the backbone to age well. Their focus has remained on crafting the very best Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon and Sonoma Pinot Noir possible. Bryter's first official vintage came in 2007 and the Ignozzis haven't looked back since.

Winemaking duties at Bryter Estates are overseen by Kari Auringer, whose hands on approach brings out the very best of every vintage. Kari has worked with some of California's great winemakers and today serves as a consulting winemaker for several boutique programs (Silver Trident, Pedras, Plume Napa Valley, and Cornerstone Cellars). She is certainly a rising star in the region and has crafted some spectacular wines over her career.

The Bryter 2014 "Cadeau" Pinot Noir comes from the Sun Chase Vineyard on California's Sonoma Coast. *Cadeau* means 'gift' and perfectly suits this wine, which is truly a gift from nature. Dark ruby in color, this Pinot Noir offers powerful yet graceful aromas and flavors of lush blackberry, black cherry, black tea and spices. Its bold, ripe black cherry core is laced with complex layers of ripe juicy fruit, savory spice, and a hint of minerality. With an underlying foundation of mouth-watering acidity, the wine unfolds into a velvety finish with well integrated tannins and a seductive hint of sweet oak. Aged 14 months in oak. Enjoy now until 2022.
