
Greenwood Ridge Vineyards 2013 Pinot Noir Mendocino Ridge

Nestled atop a 1,400-foot ridge overlooking the picturesque Anderson Valley and surrounded by nothing but lush forests of evergreen and redwood trees, Greenwood Ridge Vineyards was built to coexist with the beautiful natural surroundings of Mendocino County. The original eight vineyard acres were planted high on the Mendocino Ridge in 1972, and when Allan Green's family purchased the site the following year, the plan was to maintain the existing vineyard, sell most of the fruit, and keep some of the grapes for home winemaking. The plan changed when Allan's homegrown Riesling won a Gold Medal in 1979, and Greenwood Ridge Vineyards was born a short year later.

Allan Green grew up in Los Altos, California, just south of San Francisco. After attending college at the University of California at Riverside and then UCLA where he earned a masters in graphic design, Allan started his artistic path running a successful international graphic design business. When his parents purchased the Mendocino Ridge property, Allan was captivated by the region's beauty and eventually left the city life to pursue a future in wine country.

Initially, Greenwood Ridge Vineyards' focus was on Riesling and Cabernet Sauvignon, but the portfolio expanded over the years to include several other varietals. Each of the wines have medal-winning legacies and continue to earn praise from major international competitions. In fact, Greenwood Ridge Vineyards has been named **One of America's Top 30 Wineries** three times by *Wine and Spirits* magazine and Allan Green was awarded the **George Zeni Memorial Award** by the *Mendocino Winegrowers Alliance* in 2003 for "outstanding stewardship of the land, community service, and producing the highest quality wine grapes in Mendocino County."

Greenwood Ridge is now one of the oldest vineyards in the area. Although the winery is off the beaten path, its beautiful natural setting and award-winning wines have placed it on the radar for wine country visitors and local wine enthusiasts. If you happen to visit Mendocino, be sure to check out the Greenwood Ridge tasting room - a unique octagonal structure built from a single 400-year-old redwood tree that fell down during a storm in 1969. It was designed by Allan's father and has become a Valley landmark, providing a stunning location for sampling Greenwood Ridge wines. The wine is generously supple and full-bodied with a soft texture and lingering notes of mixed fruits, spice, and herbs. Aged 8 months in oak. 100% Pinot Noir. Enjoy now until 2021.
