Patz & Hall is the product of four talented friends, each with a passion for wine and a desire to make the best vineyard-designated wines in the simplest way possible. The winery was founded in 1988 when Donald Patz, then the national marketing manager at Flora Springs Winery, and his wife Heather approached friends James Hall and Anne Moses with the idea of creating their own label. Donald named the idea 'Project X.' James Hall was a winemaker at Honig Cellars and a former co-worker of Donald's at Flora Springs, while Anne Moses brought years of experience to the table, serving as the enologist for Far Niente and Spring Mountain wineries. Together, the team had a well-rounded background in the wine industry, and they were excited to move forward with a project they could call their own. Patz & Hall Winery was born! Taking a classic Burgundian approach with the label, Patz & Hall Winery focuses exclusively on Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, sourcing from small vineyard sites throughout Napa Valley, Russian River Valley, Mendocino, Sonoma Coast, and the Santa Lucia Highlands. Over the past twenty years, Patz & Hall has grown to produce seventeen different wines, seven Chardonnays and ten Pinot Noirs, all together representing the winery's passionate approach to winemaking and the diversity of world-class California winegrowing. The wines consistently make memorable impressions on the consuming public and their critical acclaim ranks among the top of the region.

Patz & Hall's 2009 Chenoweth Ranch Pinot Noir comes from one of the finest, smallest vineyards in Russian River Valley, located on the far western edge of the appellation in a tiny sub-region known as Green Valley. This incredibly cool-climate site is farmed exclusively for Patz & Hall, and consistently delivers some of the winery's most desirable Pinot Noir fruit. This dark, expressive 2009 vintage still shows the characteristic notes of strawberry and cherry, but there is a distinctive depth and density to this specific bottling that sets it apart from its previous releases. Its mouthcoating flavors of dark chocolate, smoke and cedar are complemented by lovely light notes of violet and lavender. *Stephen Tanzer* awards the 2009 Chenoweth Ranch Pinot Noir with **91+ POINTS**, *WineLines Online* awards it **91 POINTS**, and the *California Grapevine* follows up with **90 POINTS**, naming it **Highly Recommended**. Glen Fredericksen of WineLines Online says "Here is a wine that has attained a virtually perfect balance between fruit and oak impressions...the wine is clean and fruity, all the way to the lingering sweet fruit finish that echoes...and echoes." 
