Steve Reynolds feels he was destined to be in the wine industry since his youth. The Oklahoma native's father was in the electrical business and the family moved numerous times during Reynolds' youth, including a seven year stint in a small town just south of Munich in southern Germany. His father, who was almost fanatical about wine, was also an avid wine collector and often took the whole family on trips through Europe. It was here that Reynolds' own passion for wine really began to unfold.

After returning to the United States, Reynolds pursued a career in dentistry and eventually wound up in the Lodi-Stockton area where he held a successful dental practice and met his future wife, Suzie. The couple had friends in Napa Valley (one of which was Oscar Renteria, now an incredibly well known viticulturist and winemaker) and would often spend weekends and holidays visiting the beautiful wine country and tasting extraordinary wines. On one fateful day, during a return trip home from Napa Valley, they decided to sell the Central Valley dental practice and officially move to wine county, where they truly loved to be.

"We decided we loved Napa and I wanted to be one of those gentleman farmers making homemade wine on the side of our garage," Reynolds explained. "I started a new practice and Suzie continued to work in her family's insurance business."

The Reynolds' jump into the wine business began in earnest in 1995 when an old chicken farm on the Silverado Trail, just south of the prestigious Stags Leap District, became available. With the help of the couples' old friend Oscar Renteria, Steve Reynolds bought the property and planted vineyards to the fertile land. The first wines were made in 1999 and were incredibly well-received by friends and acquaintances, so Reynolds decided it was time to make a business of it. Reynolds Family Winery's first release of around 2,000 cases came at the start of the new millennium and today that number has grown to a comfortable level of 7,500 cases.

Through it all, Steve and Suzie Reynolds have truly enjoyed the experience and path that has lead them to where they are today. They have three beautiful children and dozens of accolades, medals, and achievements for their wines. Steve is also now one of the most sought after winemakers in the Napa Valley. He often uses complex and time consuming winemaking methods, but the results speak for themselves.
