## Ammon's Horn | 2019 Rosé of Pinot Noir Carneros, Napa Valley, California

> Gold Medal - *San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition*

A geologist-inspired winery located in the Los Carneros District of Napa Valley, Ammon's Horn was established in 2018 by Linda McGlochlin Wolff and her husband, Roger Wolff. It all began with Linda, who grew up in Carmel Valley and spent much of her childhood collecting rocks on the riverbank of her family's property. It is a fascination that stuck with Linda her entire life, and she grew up to become a geologist and hydrologist, collecting and studying such precious rocks as ammonite fossils - a personal favorite. In 1998, Linda pursued a second passion of hers (viticulture) and purchased a 6 1/2 acre property in the Los Carneros District (Spanish for 'The Rams') of Napa Valley where she planted a small Pinot Noir vineyard. When it came time to start her own winery, the name *Ammon's Horn* (inspired by the natural spirals of both ammonite fossils and Ram's Horns) seemed like the obvious choice. The Ammon's Horn 2019 Rosé of Pinot Noir offers light aromatics of white peach, kiwi, lime and hints of rose, while the bright and silky smooth palate shows balanced flavors of strawberry, cherry, green melon and key lime that lead into a lingering finish.



## Lion's Peak | 2020 'Saignée Method' Cabernet Sauvignon Rosé Paso Robles, California

One of the oldest historical vineyards on the Central Coast, Lion's Peak is set in the very heart of the Paso Robles AVA in the esteemed Estrella District. The vineyard dates back to the early 1970's when the California wine industry had a vision of establishing world-class wine that would stand toe-to-toe with ultra premium wines of France. Today, the property is owned by winemaker, Sommelier, and interior designer Jennifer Soni-Arant, who is committed to crafting highly acclaimed, sustainably grown wines that express her deep connection with nature. The Lion's Peak Vineyard is especially well-known for its Old Vine Cabernet Sauvignon that produces premium, Old World styled wines with depth and intensity. The 2020 Cabernet Sauvignon Rosé was made in the 'Saignée Method' which involves bleeding off a portion of red wine juice after contacting the skins and seeds, which increases the wine's intensity. Dry and fragrant, this beautiful wine features notes of strawberries, roses and watermelon with a refreshing finish.



## Bushong | 2021 'Pretty in Pink' Rosé Paso Robles, California

Artisan, small-lot wine producer, Jason Bushong, has been crafting eclectic, award-winning wines for over twenty years. For his Bushong Vintage Company, Jason sources fruit from some of the Central Coast's most premium vineyard sites and crafts wines that are elegant, balanced and distinctive. A quick visit to his downtown Paso Robles tasting room gives visitors a feel for Jason's authentic personality - the contemporary space is both fun and approachable and includes a vintage pinball machine and over 1,000 vinyl LP's to play on a premium hi-fi system. The Bushong 2021 'Pretty in Pink' Rosé is a vibrant Rhône-style blend of 20% Syrah, 20% Grenache, 20% Mourvèdre, 20% Tannat, and 20% Cinsault. The fresh aromas and flavors mirror each other, with notes of strawberries, lime, watermelon rind, and black raspberry, with a distinct hint of jicama coming through on the crisp finish. Enjoy!



## Lawer | 2019 Rosé of Syrah Knights Valley, Sonoma Valley, California

More than two decades ago, an Alaskan couple, David and Betsy Lawer, fell in love with wine. David Lawer, a lawyer and General Counsel for the 1st National Bank of Alaska, and Betsy Lawer, a third generation banker and the Chair and President of the Bank, found themselves visiting Napa and Sonoma Valleys during Alaska's cold winter periods and were inspired to start growing and selling premium wine grapes. They purchased one of the most unique vineyards in the Knights Valley of Sonoma Valley and couldn't resist the notion of crafting their own wines as well. Lawer Estates was formed as a tribute to the couple's love of business, whether banking or winemaking, and the label artfully merges these two worlds. The Lawer Estates 2019 Rosé of Syrah exudes notes of freshly-cut strawberries, rose petals and watermelon with bolder aromas of raspberry, grenadine, fresh plums and papaya with a refreshing herbal hint of sweet pea. The palate shows excellent balance and juicy acidity with lingering, flavorful notes of strawberry, pomegranate, grapefruit and watermelon that carry through the crisp finish.



## Silver | 2019 Rosé of Pinot Noir Premier Vineyard, Santa Barbara County, California

Who would have guessed that a kid from Amherst, Massachusetts, with degrees in Italian and Animal Sciences (Pre-Veterinary) would end up in Santa Barbara County as an up-and-coming winemaker? Benjamin Silver did just that after catching the wine bug at a summer job at Chicama Vineyards on Martha's Vineyard. Upon graduating, Benjamin moved west and began working at Santa Barbara's Zaca Mesa Winery under iconic visionary winemaker Daniel Gehrs. On the side, he began experimenting with his own small-lot wines, a hobby that laid the foundation for his namesake project, Silver Wines. In 2000, Benjamin officially launched Silver Wines, focusing on micro-production, terroir-driven wines from special vineyard sites in Santa Barbara County. The Silver 2019 Rosé of Pinot Noir opens with aromas of delicate rose petals, white flowers and ripe strawberry fruit. Bright, ripe and smooth, this Rosé shows surprising layers of fruit depth and darker fruits on the palate - so much so, that it could be mistaken for a red table wine!



## Diablo Paso | 2021 'Sin Pecado' Rosé of Grenache Paso Robles, California

Enrique and Nora Torres created Diablo Paso Wines to express the things that matter most to them: their passion for Spanish wine varietals and a commitment to hard work. After a chance meeting in a small fishing village in Guerrero, Mexico (where Enrique was raised), Enrique and Nora began a long distance courtship (Nora grew up in Brooklyn, New York and had been in Mexico studying Spanish). Eventually, the couple married and settled in Paso Robles on California's Central Coast, and it was here that they began their love affair with wine. The Torres' appreciation and respect for Old World style Spanish wines comes through in every bottle of Diablo Paso wine. The 2021 'Sin Pecado' Rosé is a blend of 95% Grenache, 3.5% Albariño, and 1.5% Tempranillo. *Sin Pecado* means 'without sin' in Spanish; as it is the Torres' intention that you enjoy this delightful Rosé without regret. Delicately fresh, this wine has light fruit aromas and lingering flavors of cherries and strawberries. Enjoy!
