South Coast | 2018 Tempranillo Rosé, Temecula Valley

Brick Barn | 2017 Grenache Rosé, Santa Ynez Valley

A historical property located in the westernmost frontier of the Santa Ynez Valley, Brick Barn Wine Estate traces its roots to the early 1970's when it served as an Arabian horse farm, complete with a 36-stall brick barn designed by an Italian stonemason. Today, the property has fulfilled its destiny, becoming a premium wine estate with 35 vineyard acres and other portions of the ranch dedicated to organic vegetable farming and cattle ranching (the brick barn has also been reimagined as a winery and tasting room). Brick Barn's 2017 Grenache Rosé is classically inspired, balancing crisp elegance with bright California flavors. On the nose, aromas of pomegranate, watermelon and lemon rind mingle together, while the soft, silky palate complements with radiant flavors of dried cherry, tangerine, and kiwi, all concluding with trailing notes of lime zest.



Tonti | 2018 Old Vine Zinfandel Rosé, Russian River Valley

Peter Tonti's interest in wine began in the 1940's when he was just a kid, watching his Italian immigrant father make wine with an old hand-cranked press in their family basement. It was a tradition that instilled in Peter a lifelong dream to honor his father's vision and to one day establish a family winery of his own. Peter finally started Tonti Family Wines in 2014, crafting a range of Zinfandels from the Russian River Valley. The vines are all farmed organically to assure the highest quality of fruit is achieved each vintage. Tonti's 2018 Old Vine Zinfandel Rosé is refreshingly dry with aromas of cassis tisane, raspberry and rhubarb and a crisp, dry body with notes of lavender and white grapefruit zest coming through on the finish.



TOLOSA

Tolosa | 2017 Pinot Noir Rosé, Edna Valley

One of Edna Valley's premier family wineries, Tolosa Winery is nestled amongst the northwest-southeast running volcanic hills of San Luis Obispo County, which is a frontier for growing complex, cool-climate varietals - especially Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. It is vintner Robin Baggett's mission to discover Edna Valley's best pockets and to create exceptional wines that are the purest expression of this distinctive appellation. Tolosa's 2017 Pinot Noir Rosé is light, shiny pink in color with a platinum rim. On the nose, notes of rose water, white nectarine, tangerine zest, kiwi flesh and orange blossom excite the senses and set the tone for the flavor-packed palate of blood orange, flowers, strawberry seeds, and a hint of freshly picked pineapple. Nice acidity and a silky texture make this wine seamless from start to finish.



Deerfield Ranch | 2018 'Checkerbloom' Syrah Rosé, Sonoma

Located in Kenwood, in the heart of Sonoma Valley, Deerfield Ranch is an award-winning, certified organic winery crafting small lots of wine from more than 26 carefully selected vineyards in Sonoma County. Deerfield Ranch was founded by owner/winemaker Robert Rex, who strives to achieve complexity, depth and rich fruit flavors in his traditionally-styled wines. In 2018, Robert Rex celebrated 46 consecutive years of winemaking, which is quite the achievement! The Deerfield Ranch 2018 'Checkerbloom' Syrah Rosé offers refreshing aromas of berries and herb tea, while the palate shows structure and focus with fruity yet dry flavors. It has incredible length and a persistent finish, which is uncommon in a Rosé, without being overweight This wine is light, bright, and tasty! Proceeds support restoration of the Kenwood Wetlands, which surround the estate vineyard and is home to the endangered Kenwood Marsh Checkerbloom.



Wirth | 2018 'Rosé the Day' Mourvèdre Rosé, Dry Creek Valley

Founded by fourth generation winemaker, Micah Wirth, Wirth Wines & Co. is located in Healdsburg, within the Dry Creek Valley. Micah comes from a family of wine pioneers and has made it his life's work to produce suburb wines, bar none. He has launched multiple winery brands including Joseph Jewell Wines, Wirth Wines & Co., and Ousterhout Wines, where he has crafted several 95+ Point wines. His latest endeavor, 'The Day Project,' focuses on Rosé and Sauvignon Blanc, with a portion of profits supporting women's rights. Wirth's 2018 Mourvèdre Rosé comes from Unti Vineyards and delivers a delightfully dry, vibrant, and crisp wine. Aromas include green apple, honeysuckle, grapefruit, strawberry and cranberry, which complement a lush mouthfeel with flavors of stone fruit, strawberry and cool minerality on the finish.
