



Scott Harvey Wines was founded in 2003, when Scott Harvey saw an opportunity to pursue a dream that his friends and supporters had been urging him to follow for a number of years. Today, his career and accomplishments rank high on the scale with other modern wine industry pioneers.

Scott's road to winemaking success began as a high school exchange student in the Rhineland Pfalz wine region of Germany where he was exposed to a number of top German wineries. After college, he returned to Germany to further his studies and eventually moved back to his hometown in Amador County to become winemaker for Story Winery and Renwood Winery. His work in Amador County helped establish the region as one of the top wine growing and wine producing regions in California, and in 1990, Dan Berger, the well-respected wine writer for the *Los Angeles Times*, named Scott Harvey one of the **'Ten Best Winemakers in America.'** Scott went on to become a partner in the successful Folie a Deux Winery in Napa Valley, and he honed his craft there for a number of years. When he learned that the entity would be sold to the Trinchero Family of Sutter Home Winery fame, he jumped at the chance to finally start his own namesake winery.

He began with the intention of producing a number of small-lot wines from top vineyards in the Sierra Foothills region. These were grape sources that Scott knew to be among the best in that part of Northern California. In 2004, Scott Harvey Wines made its inaugural release of almost 2,000 cases and the new winery was quickly on its way to gaining major critical acclaim.

The small winery's distinctive portfolio focuses on Scott's roots - Zinfandel, Syrah and Barbera from the Sierra Foothills that are approachable, food friendly, and full of luscious fruit flavors. Scott's wines have earned a remarkable number of awards and ratings since the winery's inception some fourteen years ago, and that number only continues to grow.

Scott Harvey has the ideal partner in his namesake winery venture - his wife, Jana, a long time wine industry veteran with an imposing resume of her own. She handles all of the sales and marketing for Scott Harvey Wines, and together, the Harveys continue to help establish Amador County as a world-class wine-growing appellation.

Primarily produced from the vineyards located in the Shenandoah Valley of Amador County, the 2014 'Mountain Selection' Zinfandel is a blend of 95% Zinfandel, 6% Syrah, and 2% Barbera. Aromas and flavors of chocolate covered cherries, cranberries, and mincemeat complement the rich, full mouthfeel and long, lingering finish. Aged 21 months in oak. Enjoy now until 2024.
