This light salmon-colored Rosé is made from Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre. The aromas are ripe with strawberry, rhubarb and floral notes and backed with ample acidity showcasing a lemon citrus profile. On the palate this wine is very refreshing and lively with the ripe berry flavors. The palate rounds out the composition with subtle earth notes.



Ousterhout 2017 Pinot Noir Rosé

The Zinfandel grapes were hand-picked in the Agua Dulce Vineyards located in the Santa Clarita Mountains. Winemaker Nico Azio’s notes read: “Geranium pink in color with aromas of fresh rose petal, strawberry, orange marmalade with subtle hints of citrus. On the palate flavors of passion fruit, ripe watermelon and lime zest carry through to finish.”



Vaughn Duffy 2017 Rosé of Carignan

Old Vine - Ukiah Valley

The Vaughn Duffy 2017 Rosé is made with grapes harvested from 80-year-old Carignane vines. It evokes aromas of strawberry, watermelon, tangerine and orange zest. The wine’s acidity pops on the entry to the palate. Flavors of honey crisp apple and raspberry lead to a smooth finish.
