Trinitas Cellars has been an active part of the Napa Valley wine scene for almost twenty years and has enjoyed great success with its portfolio of top flight fine wines. The winery began back in 2002 with an initial release of around 4,000 cases. Initial response to the wines was excellent, both from the consumer side and also from the commercial side of wine competitions, wine industry publications, and raters.

Through it all, Trinitas Cellars has excelled and is now considered one of the benchmark wineries of the Napa Valley. Its wines have continued their remarkable successes and are much sought after by both wine enthusiasts and collectors alike.

Trinitas Cellars was originally founded by Tim Busch and his family, with the guiding belief that with family, faith, and perseverance, anything is possible. They named the winery 'Trinitas,' which is Latin for trinity, since it is considered to be the fundamental principle of Christianity. In the Busch family's eyes, the name Trinitas (or trinity) also symbolizes sun, soil and humanity, which are the three ingredients that evoke the perfect wine. These values and beliefs have illuminated their path to building a world-class winery and, now with the second generation of the Busch family at the helm, it seems even more greatness is destined for the future. Recently, Tim's son Garrett Bush took over the ownership of Trinitas Cellars. Garret had been involved with the winery for several years, working as Director of Operations, so he was very familiar with practically every aspect of Trinitas Cellars. It is his goal to craft wine that's compellingly delicious and to continue inspiring happiness and joy through Trinitas Cellars' wines.

The winemaker for Trinitas Cellars is Kale Anderson, who has been making wine for renowned producers in Napa and Sonoma for twenty years. His career began in 2001, and it has taken him to J Winery in Russian River Valley, Colgin Cellars, working for Ann and Joe Wender, Terra Valentine Winery, Cliff Lede Vienyards in Stags Leap District, and Pahlmeyer Winery. While Director of Winemaking at Pahlmeyer, Kale became one of the youngest winemakers to earn 100 Points from Robert Parker. His talents and winemaking philosophies are a perfect match at Napa Valley's Trinitas Cellars.

Trinitas wines are available for tasting in the state-of-the-art Vista Collina Resort in the Lower Village section of Napa Valley. It is an incredible tasting experience for any wine enthusiast.

Aged in oak. 30% Old Vine Zinfandel, 20% Old Vine Petite Sirah, 20% Carignane, 12% Merlot, 7% Tinto Cao, 2% Alicante Bouschet. Enjoy!
